

## Unencoded Drug Allergies- Accuro

To ensure drug-allergy interaction checking by the EMR, select an entry under 'Allergen Groups' or 'Drugs'. **Do not use entries under 'Allergies' or use the Green Plus to add you own.** These entries are considered unencoded (free text) by the system and no interaction checking will be done.




