Fentanyl and xylazine detected in a substance tested at the Nēwo Yōtina Friendship Centre's Drug Checking site in Regina.

REGINA – October 18, 2023 - The Prescription Review Program (PRP) has been notified by the Ministry of Health that a substance tested positive for **fentanyl** and **xylazine**, which presents with a **high risk for overdose and drug toxicity deaths**.

The substance, **sold as fentanyl**, was tested at the Nēwo Yōtina Friendship Center's Drug Checking site in Regina and was presented in the form of **dark purple chunks**.

Result contains: 50-55% Erythritol/Xylitol (sugars) 20-25% Caffeine 15-20% Xylazine* 10-15% Fentanyl

Xylazine is a tranquilizer used in veterinary medicine and can go by the street name "tranq". It can lower heart rate, blood pressure and breathing. It causes sedation, muscle relaxation, and unconsciousness. Combining xylazine with other substances increases the risk of overdose and death.

Xylazine cannot be reversed with naloxone.

The *Prescription Review Program* (PRP) is Saskatchewan's prescription monitoring program. It monitors for apparent inappropriate prescribing and inappropriate use of a provincially designated panel of monitored prescription drugs, as listed in <u>Regulatory Bylaw 18.1</u>, which have been deemed subject to misuse or abuse in the province.
