

Regular Licensure

1.1 PHYSICIANS WITH CANADIAN POSTGRADUATE TRAINING

To qualify for a regular licence, a physician who has Canadian postgraduate training must:

- a) Demonstrate that the physician meets the requirements that apply to all applicants for licensure:
 - English Language Proficiency*, and
 - Credential Verification*, and
 - Examinations, and
 - Currency of Practice, and
 - Good Character, and
 - Good Standing.

b) Have obtained the designation Licentiate of the Medical Council of Canada (LMCC);

AND,

c) Attained certification with the College of Family Physicians of Canada (CCFP);

OR

d) Attained certification by the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada.

Physicians who currently hold a licence to practice in another Canadian jurisdiction: see section entitled "*Physicians with Licensure in another Canadian Jurisdiction*".

* Required if you are a physician with a foreign medical degree.
