



# Regular Licensure

## 1.1 PHYSICIANS WITH CANADIAN POSTGRADUATE TRAINING

---

To qualify for a regular licence, a physician who has Canadian postgraduate training must:

- a) Demonstrate that the physician meets the requirements that apply to all applicants for licensure:
  - English Language Proficiency\*, and
  - Credential Verification\*, and
  - Examinations, and
  - Currency of Practice, and
  - Good Character, and
  - Good Standing.

- b) Have obtained the designation Licentiate of the Medical Council of Canada (LMCC);

**AND,**

- c) Attained certification with the College of Family Physicians of Canada (CCFP);

**OR**

- d) Attained certification by the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada.

Physicians who currently hold a licence to practice in another Canadian jurisdiction: see section entitled "*Physicians with Licensure in another Canadian Jurisdiction*".

**\* Required if you are a physician with a foreign medical degree.**
