2.9 CONDITIONS AND REQUIREMENTS OF PROVISIONAL ACADEMIC LICENSURE

To qualify for a provisional academic licence, a physician must:

1. Demonstrate that the physician meets the following requirements for licensure:
 - English Language Proficiency*, and
 - Credential Verification*, and
 - Currency of Practice.

and,

2. Be engaged by the College of Medicine;

and,

3. In the opinion of the Registrar, is of renowned reputation and the physician will be receiving a full-time academic appointment at the University of Saskatchewan, College of Medicine.

Conditions of a Provisional Academic Licence:

- a. A physician who is licensed with an Academic Licence is required to maintain the full-time academic position with the University of Saskatchewan, College of Medicine which qualified the physician for Academic licensure.
- b. An Academic licence granted to a physician who fails to meet the requirement for a full-time academic position will automatically be revoked and cease to be valid.

* Required if you are a physician with a foreign medical degree.
