



Ministerial Licensure

4.3 LICENSURE FOR SASKATCHEWAN CANCER AGENCY SPECIALISTS

To qualify for a Ministerial licence, a physician must:

1. Demonstrate that the physician meets the requirements that apply to all applicants for licensure:
 - English Language Proficiency*; and,
 - Credential Verification*; and,
 - Examinations; and,
 - Currency of Practice; and,
 - Good Character; and,
 - Good Standing.

2. Be engaged with the Saskatchewan Cancer Agency; **and,**
3. Hold a specialty qualification acceptable to the Council; **and,**
4. Produce evidence in a form and manner that may be prescribed by Council that the applicant:
 - a. is a graduate in medicine of a university approved by the Council; **and,**
 - b. meets registration requirements; **and**
 - c. provides all required documentation and fees.

Conditions related to Ministerial Licensure for a Saskatchewan Cancer Agency Specialist:
<ol style="list-style-type: none">a. The Ministerial licence only authorizes the physician to practise with the Saskatchewan Cancer Agency with respect to which the Minister's request was made.b. A Ministerial licence shall be automatically revoked and cease to be valid if the holder of the licence ceases to work in the position with respect to which the Minister's request was made.

** Required if you are a physician with a foreign medical degree.*
