Good Standing

CERTIFICATE OF PROFESSIONAL CONDUCT

Applicants must provide a document from the regulatory or licensing authority in each other jurisdiction where the applicant is currently registered or licensed for the practice of medicine or another health profession:

- certifying that the applicant's entitlement to practise medicine or another health profession has not been cancelled, suspended, limited, restricted, or subject to conditions in that jurisdiction at any time, or specifying particulars of any such cancellation, suspension, limitation, restriction, or conditions, and
- 2. certifying that there is no investigation, review, or other proceeding underway in that jurisdiction which could result in the applicant's entitlement to practise medicine or another health profession being cancelled, suspended, limited, restricted, or subjected to conditions, or specifying particulars of any such investigation, review, or other proceeding.
