



Good Character

The applicant's past and present conduct afford reasonable grounds for belief that the applicant:

- (i) is mentally competent to practise medicine;
- (ii) will practise medicine with decency, integrity and honesty and in accordance with the law;
- (iii) has sufficient knowledge, skill and judgment to engage in the kind of medical practice authorized by the certificate;

and,

- (iv) can communicate effectively and will display an appropriately professional attitude.
