Dr. Jeremy Reed admitted that he had engaged in unprofessional conduct in Alberta. Among the findings of the discipline committee of the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Alberta were that:

In this document, Dr. Reed admits the allegations in the Amended Amended Notice of Hearing are true and that his conduct amounts to unprofessional conduct.

- and -

As Dr. Reed admitted to inappropriately causing or permitting a photograph to be taken of him and a patient, an act contrary to section 23 of the *Health Information Act*, and inappropriate disclosure of confidential information of two patients to people unconnected to their care, an act contrary to section 31 of the *Health Information Act*, the Tribunal finds his conduct in these matters to be "unprofessional conduct", as defined in s. 1 (1)(pp) of the HPA.

The Alberta College of Physicians and Surgeons imposed a 10-day suspension from practice. The College of Physicians and Surgeons of Saskatchewan is authorized to take disciplinary action against a physician who has been found guilty of unprofessional conduct in another jurisdiction (section 54.01 of *The Medical Profession Act, 1981*).

Council accepted the joint recommendation made by counsel for Dr. Reed and the Registrar's office and imposed a 10-day suspension commencing December 8, 2012.
