MOTION

THAT, pursuant to Section 54(1) of *The Medical Profession Act, 1981*, Dr. Ian Cowan is hereby suspended for a period of two months, with the suspension itself suspended on the condition that Dr. Cowan has not committed any further actions of unprofessional conduct in the period subsequent to June 18, 2001 and will not commit further acts of unprofessional conduct for the period ending June 17, 2003. In the event that Dr. Cowan does not engage in, and has not engaged in, any conduct within that two-year period that results in a finding of unbecoming, improper, unprofessional or discreditable conduct, Dr. Cowan will not be required to serve this suspension. If Dr. Cowan is found to have committed an act of unbecoming, improper, unprofessional or discreditable conduct, and that conduct occurs within the period June 18, 2001 and June 17, 2003, Dr. Cowan will, upon being found guilty, be immediately suspended for a period of two months pursuant to this motion.
