



Regular Licensure

1.1 PHYSICIANS WITH CANADIAN POSTGRADUATE TRAINING

To qualify for a regular licence, a physician who has Canadian postgraduate training must:

- a) Demonstrate that they meet the requirements that apply to all forms of licensure outlined in [Bylaw 2.3](#):
 - English Language Proficiency*, and
 - Credential Verification*, and
 - Currency of Practice, and
 - Good Character, and
 - Good Standing, and
 - Evidence of appropriate Medical Knowledge.

AND,

- b) Attained certification with the College of Family Physicians of Canada (CCFP);

OR

- c) Attained certification by the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada.

Physicians who currently hold a licence to practice in another Canadian jurisdiction: see section entitled "*Physicians with Licensure in another Canadian Jurisdiction.*"

**** Required if you are a physician with a foreign medical degree.***
