



# Regular Licensure

## 1.2 PHYSICIANS WITH AMERICAN POSTGRADUATE TRAINING

To qualify for a regular licence, a physician who has American postgraduate training must:

1. Demonstrate that the physician meets the requirements that apply to all applicants for licensure:
  - English Language Proficiency\*, and
  - Credential Verification\*, and
  - Examinations, and
  - Currency of Practice, and
  - Good Character, and
  - Good Standing.

2. Demonstrate that the physician meets the following:

Certification requirements for a Regular Licensure for physicians with American Postgraduate Training	
The physician must have:	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. Attained certification by the College of Family Physicians of Canada (CCFP); <b>or,</b></li> <li>b. Certification by the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada (RCPSC); <b>or,</b></li> <li>c. Attained certification from a member board of the American Board of Medical Specialties; <b>and,</b></li> <li>d. Received an independent or full licence or certificate of registration to practise without restrictions in the United States; <b>or,</b></li> <li>e. Eligibility for an independent or full licence or certificate of registration to practise without restrictions in the United States.</li> </ol>

*\* Required if you are a physician with a foreign medical degree.*
