

Regular Licensure

1.2 PHYSICIANS WITH AMERICAN POSTGRADUATE TRAINING

To qualify for a regular licence, a physician who has American postgraduate training must:

- 1. Demonstrate that the physician meets the requirements that apply to all applicants for licensure:
 - English Language Proficiency*, and
 - Credential Verification*, and
 - Examinations or provides proof of medical knowledge acceptable to Council, and
 - Currency of Practice, and
 - Good Character, and
 - Good Standing.

2. Demonstrate that the physician meets the following:

Certification requirements for a Regular Licensure for physicians with American Postgraduate Training	
The physician must have:	Canadian Certification Attained
	a. Attained certification by the College of Family Physicians of Canada (CCFP);
	or,
	b. Certification by the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada (RCPSC);
	American Board Certification Attained
	a. Attained certification from a member board of the American Board of Medical Specialties;
	and,
	b. Received an independent or full licence or certificate of registration to practise without restrictions in the United States;
	or,
	c. Eligibility for an independent or full licence or certificate of registration to practise without restrictions in the United States.

* Required if you are a physician with a foreign medical degree.
