The Executive Committee of the College of Physicians and Surgeons directs that, pursuant to section 47.5 of *The Medical Profession Act, 1981*, the Discipline Committee hear the following charges against Dr. Nigel Painter, namely:

1. You, Dr. Nigel Painter are guilty of unbecoming, improper, unprofessional, or discreditable conduct contrary to the provisions of section 46(o) and/or section 46(p) of *The Medical Profession Act, 1981*, S.S. 1980-81, c. M-10.1, and/or bylaw 7.2(h) and/or bylaw 8.1(b)(xvi) of the Regulatory Bylaws of the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Saskatchewan, particulars whereof are that you committed touch of a sexual nature of your patient and/or made inappropriate sexual comments to your patient.

The evidence that will be led in support of this charge will include one or more of the following:

- a) Patient number 1 was your patient since 2011.
 - b) During an appointment on or about May 12, 2021, you touched Patient number 1 in a sexual manner through her clothing. The touches included one or more of Patient number 1's buttocks, legs, breast, or vaginal area.
- You also made inappropriate sexual comments to Patient number 1 at the appointment on May 12, 2021 and/or in a telephone conversation on or about May 14, 2021.
