The Council of the College of Physicians and Surgeons imposes the following penalties on Dr. Nigel Painter pursuant to *The Medical Profession Act, 1981*:

1. Pursuant to Section 54(1)(a) of *The Medical Profession Act, 1981*, the name of Dr. Nigel Painter is struck from the Register of the College of Physicians and Surgeons with immediate effect;
2. Pursuant to Section 54(1)(a) of the Act, Dr. Painter shall not be eligible to have his name restored to the Register until a period of 2 years has elapsed from the effective date of revocation of his licence;
3. Pursuant to section 54(1)(a) of the Act, Dr. Painter shall not be eligible to have his name restored to the Register until the following conditions are met: a. A period of 2 years has elapsed from the effective date of revocation of his licence; and b. The Council receives a satisfactory report from a professional person, persons or organization acceptable to the Council which attests that Dr. Painter has undertaken counselling at his expense for sexual abuse, has gained insight into the matter and has achieved a measure of rehabilitation which protects the public from risk of future harm from Dr. Painter. Such a report may be provided by Alliance Assessment Center in Houston, TX or such other persons or organizations that are acceptable to the Registrar of the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Saskatchewan;
4. Pursuant to section 54(1)(i) of the Act, the Council directs Dr. Painter to pay the costs of and incidental to the investigation and hearing in the amount of \$84,000. Such payment shall be paid in full before Dr. Painter is eligible to have his name restored to the Register.
